Slayton is a native of Troy, Alabama and holds an undergraduate and Masters Degree from Alabama A&M University in Huntsville, Alabama. He was awarded the Outstanding Alumnus Citation by his Alma Mater and also received the University’s Distinguished Service Award. Over the years, Slayton has also received numerous meritorious awards from community based organizations in Georgia.
